


**WHEREAS,** Supervisor Mulliken also served as Chairman of Land Conservation, Resource Planning and Museum & Archives.



**TO THE DOOR COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS:**

**WHEREAS,** Door County is empowered to operate a Comprehensive Community Services Program ("CCSP") under Ch.. DHS 36 Wis. Adm. Code, namely a county-wide community-based psychosocial rehabilitation program that is operated by a county department to provide or arrange for the provision of psychosocial rehabilitation services; and

**WHEREAS,** There is a demonstrated need for a CCSP within Door County; and

**WHEREAS,** The Door County Department of Human Services ("DHS") seeks to apply, to the Wisconsin Department of Health Services ("DHS"), for certification to provide comprehensive community services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** That the Door County Board of Supervisors hereby supports the development of a CCSP, to be operated by the Department of Human Services, with a projected start-up date of July 1, 2014, all consistent with applicable statutes and codes, including under Ch.. DHS 36 Wis. Adm. Code and Sec.'s 49.45(30e)(b), 49.46(2)(b)6. Lm, & 51.42(7)(b), Wis. Stats.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That the Door County DHS is authorized, by and through its Director and subject to the oversight of the Human Services Board, to submit an application to the Wisconsin DHS for certification to provide comprehensive community services ("CCS") and take whatever other action is required to timely develop and start-up a CCSP.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** That a CCS Coordination Committee is hereby created, under Sec. DHS 36.09, Wis. Stats. to advise and assist the Door County DHS in the development and quality improvement of CCS.
