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TB Testing

TB Skin Tests

TB skin tests are available from your doctor, clinic or through your local public health department. They may be obtained for a small fee through the Door County Health Department. A TB skin test can be obtained during scheduled immunization clinics. The TB skin test will need to be read 48-72 hours after it is given.

Those required to have two-step testing need to arrange their own testing during scheduled immunization clinics. If the first TB skin test is negative, then a second TB skin test would need to be given 7-21 days after the first test. There is a small fee for each TB skin test.

TB blood tests:

Currently the only blood test available in Door County is the QuantiFERON-TB Gold. Please contact your physician for this test.
