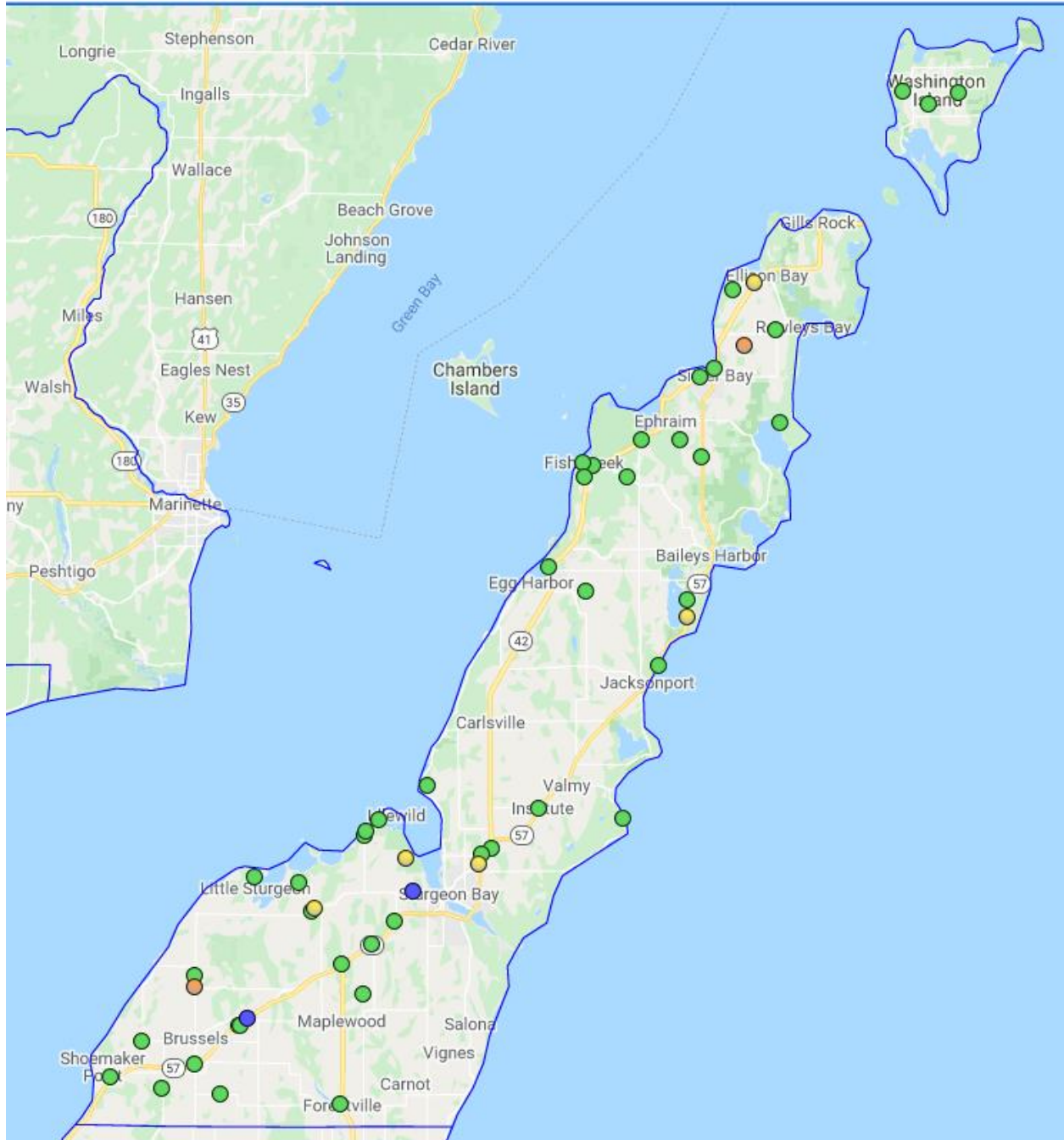

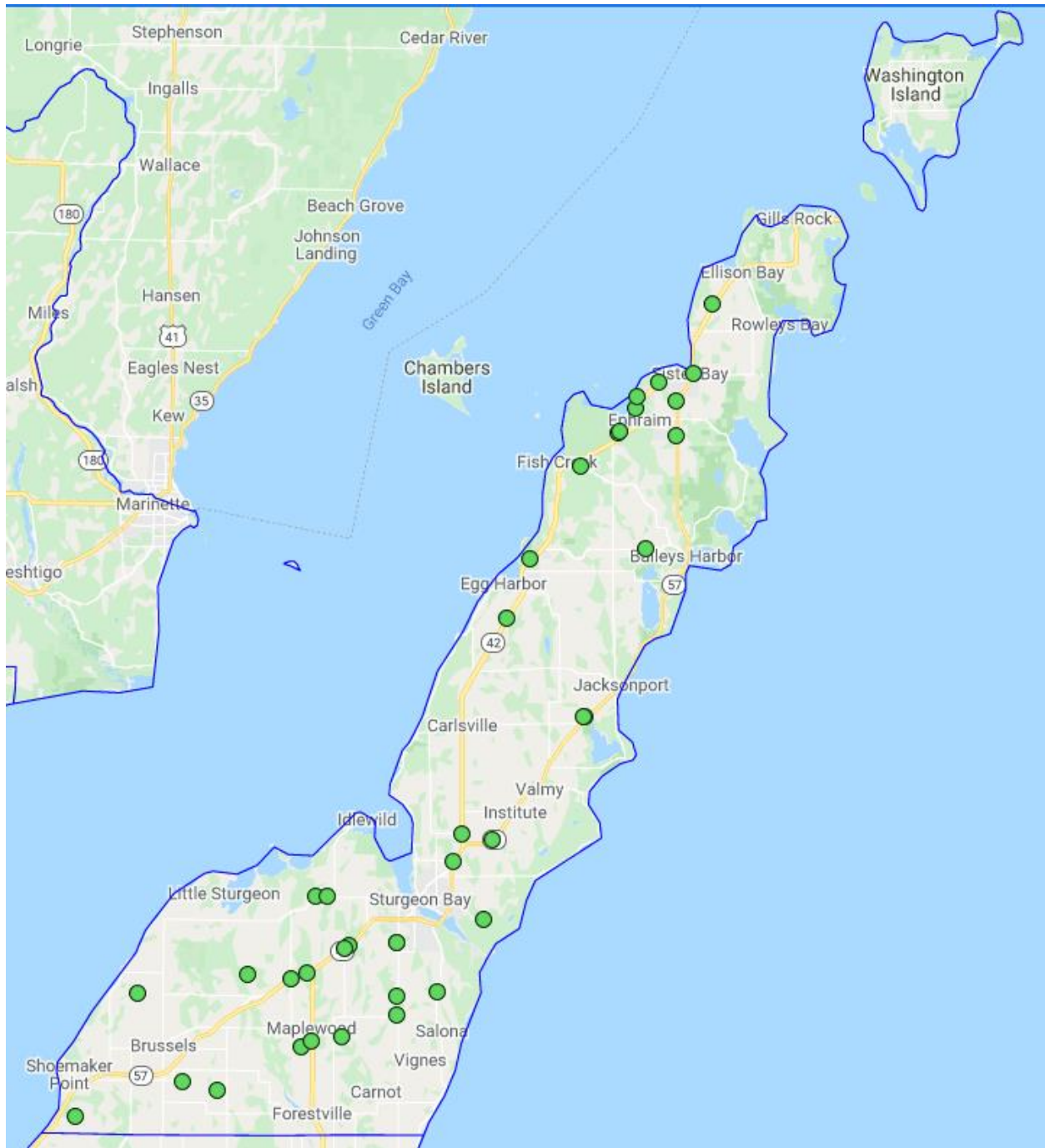
Minutes:

1. **Call to Order**
Chairman Roy Englebort called the meeting to order at 9:09 a.m.
2. **Establish a quorum – agency representatives in attendance:** Roy Englebort, John Kolodziej, David Englebort, Brad Shortreed, Karyn Behling, Chad Shefchik, Bob Schultz, Jenny Austin, Randy Wiessinger, and Randy Asman.
3. **Adopt the agenda**
Motion by Englebort, seconded by Kolodziej, to adopt the agenda. Motion carried.
4. **Introduction of guests:** None.
5. **Public Participation:** None
6. **Correspondence:** None
7. **Minutes of November 5, 2020, 4th quarter meeting**
Motion by Kolodziej, seconded by Englebort, to approve the minutes of the November 5, 2020 meeting. Motion carried.
8. **Pending, continued, “old” business**
 - A. Safety concerns for the intersection of STH 42/57 and CTH U (Clay Banks Road).
Kolodziej reported that the DOT is working with the City and County to improve the safety and functionality of the intersection. A meeting was held with City, County and State reps to talk about the project. There was discussion about looking into a roundabout, and it was determined not to pursue a roundabout at this time. It is a long term goal for when development starts to increase. A roundabout would add significant costs.
The project is planned to go ahead in 2023 unless additional funding is available earlier. The next step is to work out the final costs share agreement. The county’s share will be approximately \$75,000. There will be a Public Informational meeting in the future.
9. **New Business:** None
10. **DOT Update**
Randy Asman said he had nothing new to report. The DOT is still telecommuting and conducting business as usual.
11. **BOTS Update (Bureau of Transportation Safety)**
Randy Wiessinger reported that Door County had two fatalities in 2020; with the five year average at four. There were 30% less crashes in 2020 compared to 2019. Motorcycle crashes were up 33% in Door County and 40% Statewide. He will forward his Quarterly Informational Slides to be sent to all members.
12. **Review of ‘Spot Maps’**
 - A. 4th Quarter 2020
The fourth quarter had a total of 177 crashes (0 fatalities, 28 injury, and 122 deer crashes).
