
Dunes Lake Restoration LCC Tour Itinerary

1. Rubber boots or water shoes


Items you may want to bring but are not required:

Dunes Lake Project Areas for 2020 RFP


Project ranking is based on ecological habitat, previous treatments, & habitat degradation.

Descriptions of Rank Categories Identified within Dunes Lake 2020 RFP			
Rank Category	Stand description	Approximate Acreage	Allowable Treatment Methods
1	Areas treated in 2016 or higher quality fringe sedge meadow areas. Treatment addressing cattail/phragmites	15	Hand swipe or spot praying depending on density and feasibility
2	Areas treated in 2016 or secondary quality sedge meadow areas. Treatment addressing cattail/phragmites or dense Phragmites patches	11	Hand swipe or spot praying depending on density and feasibility
3	Cattail areas treated in 2019 (depending on permissions). Treatment addressing cattail. May or may not be treated based on funding.	3	Backpack or 'marshmaster' where required for feasibility
4	Areas of cattail mixing with native bulrush stands. Edge of extensive cattail stands. Treatment addressing cattail. May or may not be treated based on funding.	4	Backpack or 'marshmaster' where required for feasibility
5	Individual phragmites populations at varying sizes. May or may not be treated based on funding.	3	Spot praying or backpack spraying depending on density and feasibility
