The purpose of the meetings is to provide the public with opportunities to offer comment to the Department of Health and Human Services' Board members and staff regarding any aspect of the agency administration, programming or budget for 2021.

The agency provides a comprehensive array of statutorily defined services to Door County residents experiencing challenges in the areas of mental health, alcohol and other drug abuse, developmental disabilities, child protection, juvenile justice, economic support, long term care, adult protective services, the Aging and Disability Resource Center (ADRC) and Public Health.
