1 The Door County Board of Supervisors does hereby ordain as follows:  
 2  
 3 (1) AUTHORITY  
 4 (a) This ordinance, designated as Chapter 10 of the Door County Code, is  
 5 enacted under the authority granted by Sections 59.02 and 59.54(4)  
 6 and (4m) Wisconsin Statutes.  
 7  
 8 (2) PURPOSE  
 9 (a) Public protection and safety;  
 10 (b) Aiding in law enforcement, fire protection, emergency services and  
 11 civil defense;  
 12 (c) Alleviate confusion and difficulties by elimination of duplicate names  
 13 or numbers by mandating adequate signage, and by requiring  
 14 uniformity.  
 15 (d) Assist public and private entities in the timely and efficient delivery of  
 16 goods and services.  
 17  
 18 (3) JURISDICTION AND APPLICABILITY  
 19 (a) This ordinance shall be applicable to all unincorporated areas of the  
 20 County of Door, State of Wisconsin.  
 21 (b) This ordinance shall be applicable to each rural road, home, business,  
 22 farm or other establishment whether in existence prior or subsequent  
 23 to enactment of this ordinance.  
 24  
 25 (4) UNIFORM NAMING SYSTEM  
 26 (a) Each rural road shall be assigned a name or number in compliance  
 27 with Door County's "Uniform Addressing Manual".  
 28 (b) Door County's "Uniform Addressing Manual", or as subsequently  
 29 amended or revised, is incorporated herein by reference.  
 30  
 31 (5) UNIFORM NUMBERING SYSTEM  
 32 (a) Each home, business, farm or other establishment shall be assigned a  
 33 name or number in compliance with Door County's "Uniform  
 34 Addressing Manual".  
 35 (b) Door County's "Uniform Addressing Manual", or as subsequently  
 36 amended or revised, is incorporated herein by reference.  
 37  
 38 (6) UNIFORM SIGNS  
 39 (a) Names or numbers shall be displayed on uniform signs posted on  
 40 rural roads and intersections, and at each home, business farm or  
 41 other establishment in compliance with Door County's "Uniform  
 42 Addressing Manual".  
 43 (b) Door County's "Uniform Addressing Manual", or as subsequently  
 44 amended or revised, is incorporated herein by reference.  
 45  
 46 (7) ADMINISTRATION / ENFORCEMENT / PENALTIES / RELATIONSHIP TO  
 47 OTHER LAWS  
 48 (a) The Door County Planning Department shall administer this  
 49 ordinance.  
 50 (b) Enforcement of this ordinance may be by use of citation(s) if and as  
 51 provided by Ch. 35 of the Door County Code, by commencement of a  
 52 civil action, or as otherwise provided by law.  
 53 (c) Any person who violates this ordinance shall pay a forfeiture of not  
 54 less than \$150.00 nor more than \$500.00, and shall pay all fees, costs,  
 55 and disbursements associated with enforcement and prosecution. A  
 56 separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on  
 57 which a violation occurs or continues.  
 58 (d) The issuance of a citation, commencement of a civil action, or entry of  
 59 a judgment under this ordinance shall not preclude the County of  
 60 Door from proceeding under any other ordinance or law relating to  
 61 the same or any other matter.  
 62  
 63 (8) SEVERABILITY  
 64 (a) If any provision of this ordinance is held to be void, invalid,  
 65 unconstitutional or unenforceable by a court of competent  
 66 jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this ordinance shall not be  
 67 affected thereby.  
 68  
 69 (9) EFFECTIVE DATE  
 70 (a) This ordinance shall take effect on the day following the date of  
 publication.
