Door County is again partnering with the Wisconsin National Guard to offer free COVID-19 testing for the community on a weekly basis beginning January 4, 2021 thru March 8, 2021. Testing will occur on most Monday's (Federal Holidays excluded) 8:00am - 4:00 PM
