Flu Vaccine Clinics Set by Door County Public Health

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC), recommends that everyone 6 months and older get an annual flu vaccine. This year, with COVID-19 spreading during flu season, it is more important than ever to get vaccinated against the flu. While it won't protect you against COVID-19, it can protect you from the flu and keep you and your loved ones out of an already overburdened health care system. Our clinics will be conducted in drive-up fashion again this year. Please see attached flyer for dates, times, and locations.

There will be a \$39.00 fee (checks only) for the standard flu vaccine for adults. We will also be offering the high dose flu vaccine for those age 65 and older. **There will be a \$70.00 fee for the adjuvanted vaccine for adults age 65 and older.** (An adjuvant is an ingredient in a vaccine that helps promote a better immune response.) For adults with Medicare, Part B covers the cost of either vaccine; individuals with traditional Medicare Part B, Humana Medicare Advantage Plan, or United Health Care Medicare Advantage Plan are requested to bring their insurance cards to the clinic site. We are not able to bill other types of insurance. School aged children, age 4 through 18 years, can receive the vaccine free-of-cost to them at the drive thru clinic, regardless of insurance status, through special state program. For children younger than age 4, please call us for an appointment at our office.

Pfizer (age 12 and up) and Johnson and Johnson (age 18 and up) COVID-19 Vaccine will also be available at drive-up clinics. We will offer first dose, second dose and third additional dose to those who qualify. You may receive both Influenza and COVID vaccine at the same time.

To help expedite the process we ask that you do the following:

1. Wear short sleeves and have your arm readily accessible
2. Have your Medicare card available (if applicable)
3. Payment \$39.00 or \$70.00 depending on vaccine preference (checks payable to Door County Public Health). **We can accept only checks or exact cash.**
4. Cloth Face coverings are required

Routine vaccination should be deferred for persons with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, regardless of symptoms, until criteria have been met for them to discontinue isolation. While mild illness is not a contraindication to vaccination, vaccination visits for these individuals should be postponed avoiding exposing healthcare personnel and other patients to the virus that causes COVID-19
