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**UPDATED INFLUENZA AND COVID-19 DRIVE-THRU CLINIC HOURS  
 NEW VACCINE BOOSTER RECOMMENDATIONS**

Door County Public Health has expanded the times of their remaining drive-thru clinic hours in an effort to offer more opportunity to receive the Seasonal Influenza and Covid-19 Vaccine. Door County Public Health has Influenza and High-Dose Influenza (for those age 65 and older), Pfizer and Johnson and Johnson COVID-19 vaccine available at drive-up clinics. **You may receive both Infuenza and COVID vaccine at the same time.**

The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) recommends that everyone 6 months and older get an annual flu vaccine.

CDC now recommends that certain people are now eligible to receive a COVID-19 booster shot, including those who received Moderna and Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccines. Eligible individuals may choose which vaccine they receive as a booster dose. Some people may have a preference for the vaccine type that they originally received, and others may prefer to get a different booster. CDC's recommendations now allow for this type of mix and match dosing for booster shots.

For those who received **Johnson & Johnson** COVID-19 vaccine and are aged 18 and older, a booster dose is recommended no sooner than 2 full months after receiving the first dose.

For those who received **Moderna or Pfizer** COVID-19 vaccine, it is recommended that certain populations receive a booster dose no sooner than 6 months after receiving their second dose of Moderna or Pfizer (**Example:** if you received your second dose of Pfizer or Moderna on May 14, you are eligible to receive your booster on or after November 14).

**COVID-19 vaccines are safe, effective, and free!**

**There will be a \$39.00 fee (checks only) for the standard flu vaccine for adults.** We will also be offering the high dose flu vaccine for those age 65 and older. **There will be a \$70.00 fee for the high dose vaccine for adults age 65 and older.** For adults with Medicare, Part B covers the cost of either vaccine; individuals with traditional Medicare Part B, Humana Medicare Advantage Plan, or United Health Care Medicare Advantage Plan are requested to bring their insurance cards to the clinic site. We are not able to bill other types of insurance. School aged children, age 4 through 18 years, can receive the flu vaccine free-of-cost to them at the drive thru clinic, regardless of insurance status, through a special state program. For children younger than age 4, please call us for an appointment at our office.

**To help expedite the process we ask that you do the following:**

1. Wear short sleeves and have your arm readily accessible
2. Have your Medicare card available (if applicable)
3. Payment \$39.00 or \$70.00 depending on vaccine preference (checks payable to Door County Public Health). **We can accept only checks or exact cash.**
4. **Please bring your COVID vaccination card with you to your appointment**
5. **Print and complete consent forms ahead of time.** Forms can be found on our website at [Door County COVID-19 Situation Update | Door County, WI](#) Forms will be available at the site if not completed ahead of time.
6. ***Cloth Face coverings are required***

***Routine vaccination should be deferred for persons with suspected or confirmed COVID-19, regardless of symptoms, until criteria have been met for them to discontinue isolation.*** While mild illness is not a contraindication to vaccination, vaccination visits for these individuals should be postponed avoiding exposing healthcare personnel and other patients to the virus that causes COVID-19
