### **Door County Public Health COVID-19 Vaccine Clinics**

Door County Public Health continues its dedicated efforts to provide COVID-19 vaccinations to all those eligible. Our top priority for Door County remains focused on minimizing the number of adverse outcomes due to COVID-19, including hospitalizations and deaths. People are best protected from severe COVID-19 illness when they stay up to date with their COVID-19 vaccines, which includes a booster for many people. COVID-19 vaccine boosters can further enhance or restore protection that might have waned over time after your primary series vaccination.

Door County Public Health continues to provide COVID-19 vaccinations and host weekly vaccine clinics on Tuesday afternoons in Sturgeon Bay, along with special monthly clinics in Sister Bay and Washington Island. COVID vaccine is administered at no charge, with no insurance information or ID needed.
